

## Jodie Bell – Goolarri Media



Jodie is a descendant of the Butchella and Jagera people of South East Queensland, but has spent most of her life living in Western Australia.

Jodie has been with Goolarri Media Enterprises, a community-owned Indigenous media company, since early 2008, following 12 years as CEO of Marra Worra Worra, the largest Aboriginal Resource Centre in the Kimberley region.

Prior to this Jodie worked for ATSIC in the Commonwealth Government, working across the East and West Kimberley, assisting groups to acquire and develop pastoral leases, and set up small micro-enterprises in remote communities.

Jodie has been a Director of Bandaral Ngadu Pty and KRSP Pty Ltd and is a Director on the Board of RAMU Productions Pty Ltd, Goolarri's Production Company and the National Indigenous Radio Service (NIRS) Ltd.

Jodie has also held a number of community positions such as the Chair of the Fitzroy Crossing District High School Council for 6 years and Inaugural Chair of the Aboriginal Workforce Development Centre in the West Kimberley from 2010 – 2013.
