Tony had professional career spanning 35 years with KPMG Victoria, 25 years of which were as a partner with a major focus on Corporate Finance until he retired in 2001.

He specialised in utilities reform and privatisation in the electricity and gas industries in Victoria including co-leadership of the privatisation of the South Australia electricity industry and advice to the Korean Government and other Asian countries on potential privatisation in those countries. He has been a Member of the APEC Finance Ministers' Privatisation Forum.

He continues to provide independent specialist advice to governments and industry and has successfully owned and operated a variety of small to medium sized enterprises in Broome.

He was President of the Broome Chamber of Commerce & Industry from 2008 to 2014 and spearheaded the doubling of membership over that period and was a Governing Council member of the Kimberley Training Institute from 2009 to 2015.

In 2014 he wrote the BCCI submission to the Commonwealth Parliament's Joint Select Committee on the Development of Northern Australia and was a Member of the ADC Forum's Northern Development Summit Working Group on Policy, Financing and Governance.
