Warren has always aspired to be a leader among his peers and this was again proven when Warren joined the Western Australian Police in 1999. During his time in training at the WA Police Academy, Warren was selected as the very first Aboriginal Squad Leader. He went on to fulfil a very successful policing career having worked in metropolitan, country and remote locations across Western Australia. In 2006, whilst policing in the remote community of Kalumburu, Warren was selected as a Nominee for the Community Person of the Year Award.

After the WA Police Service, Warren went onto various senior management positions such as General Manager and CEO roles. In 2011, Warren was selected as a Director for the company Waardi Limited which was the Administrative Body for the Precinct Project Agreement representing the traditional owner's rights and interests. Soon after Warren was elected as the Inaugural Chairman of the Company and served till 2015.

Warren has always had a passion for Community Development and prosperity. Warren is currently the Head Coach for the Derby Tiger's Football Club and over the years has played a mentoring role to many young aspiring young leaders having coached at local and regional levels.
